Educational background	Dr. Malik is an RCSI Dublin, Bahrain and Dubai alumnus. He obtained his medical degree in Dublin, postgraduate diploma in Health Professions Education in Bahrain, and master's degree in Leadership and Innovation in Healthcare in Dubai. He also holds the Certificate in Learning and Teaching in Higher Education from Advance HE.
Summary of Career to date.	After completing the Family Practice Residency Program in Bahrain, Dr. Malik was awarded the Arab Board Certification in Family Medicine and the Family Medicine Specialty certificate, which is accredited by both the Ministry of Health (MOH) in Bahrain and RCSI. During his work as a Family Physician for the MOH, Dr. Malik concurrently worked part-time at RCSI-MUB as the Clinical Skills coordinator. He then joined RCSI Bahrain as a Lecturer in Family Medicine and module lead for the Introduction to Professional Clinical Practice course in 2020. Dr. Malik also practices part-time as a Consultant Family Physician in his private clinic.

Major accomplishments	Dr. Malik held multiple supervisorial and coordinator roles while working for the MOH. He was appointed as the Quality Enhancement (QE) coordinator in October 2018. In June 2019, Dr. Malik was an instrumental member of the QE team that achieved Canadian Accreditation for Primary Health and all public sector health centers under the Qmentum International accreditation program, with 99.1% of criteria met. This was the first Diamond status accreditation achieved by Bahrain's MOH for Primary Health.
