Before you start make sure that your name in your Bachelor's Degree and Transcripts is spelt as per your valid passport. You must retain the same nationality and passport name for the duration of the programme in RCSI Medical University of Bahrain.

What is Authentication of Documents and why is it needed?

Academic qualifications intended for use in another country must be "authenticated" or "legalized" in order to be recognized as valid in that country. The Higher Education Council (HEC) Bahrain requires all students commencing studies in Bahrain to obtain authentication of their High School/Secondary Transcript, Diploma and Degrees.

You are required to submit the following	
In Bahrain	 Original Bachelors Degree and Transcript of Records An Equivalency Letter issued by the Higher Education Council
Out of Bahrain	 Original Bachelors Degree and Transcript of Records An Equivalency Letter (where available) Stamp all the above documents from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Bahrain Embassy in the country where the Bachelors Degree was awarded Stamp all the above documents from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bahrain
Alternative Option	Original Bachelors Degree and Transcript of Records Apostilled. If your country is a member of Hague Convention, the above can be attested using Apostille.
