

Authentication of Academic Documents from Canada

Before you start make sure that your name in your academic documents is spelt as per your valid passport. You must retain the same nationality and passport name for the duration of the programme in RCSI Medical University of Bahrain.

What is Authentication of Documents and why is it needed?

Academic qualifications intended for use in another country must be “authenticated” or “legalized” in order to be recognized as valid in that country. The Higher Education Council (HEC) Bahrain requires all students commencing studies in Bahrain to obtain authentication of their High School/Secondary Transcript, Diploma and Degrees.

You are required to submit the following

High School Diploma in Canada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original High School Transcripts of Grade 9 to 12 and High School Diploma • Stamp all the above documents from a Notary Public in Canada • Stamp all the above documents from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Global Affairs in Canada
Bachelors Degree in Canada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original University Transcripts & Bachelors Degree • Stamp all the above documents from a Notary Public in Canada • Stamp all the above documents from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Global Affairs in Canada

Important Notes:

- A scanned copy of your attested documents with the required stamps visible must be sent via email to attestbahrain@rcsi.com for our review and confirmation.
- If true copies are attested, the unattested original documents must also be submitted.
