Required Subjects Science stream at standard **grade 12 (XII)**

Applicants must have studied Mathematics to at least standard **grade 10 (X)**.

Minimum Grade Minimum Grade Point Average (**GPA**) of **70%** at standard **grade 12 (XII)**.

English language requirements Applicants are **required** to complete an English language examination (**Aptis**).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Secondary School Transcripts / Certificates (Grades 9,10, 11 & 12 to date)
- Predicted grades for final year
- Academic Reference Form to be completed, signed and stamped by the school or University
- A letter of good conduct (only applicable to applicants completing High School in Bahrain)
- University Transcripts / Certificates (if applicable)
- Scanned copy of passport, including photo page
- Scanned copy of CPR/GCC or other National Identity Card (if applicable)
- Passport-style photograph

All applicants must have completed a minimum 12 years of schooling by the end of secondary school education.
