Conferring takes place in **December 2022**.

MEMBERSHIP AWARD PROCESS

Applicants complete an online portfolio of evidence via the Faculty's ePortfolio

Membership requires applicants to complete a reflective portfolio providing evidence of the applicant's personal and professional qualifications and their ongoing engagement with lifelong learning and continuing professional development (CPD).

The portfolio enables the applicant to demonstrate their understanding and use of concepts such as reflective process, clinical supervision, preceptorship/mentorship, clinical decision making and teamwork in their clinical practice.

An External Examiner reviews all aspects of the process ensuring that standards and quality assurance processes are maintained.
