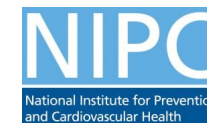

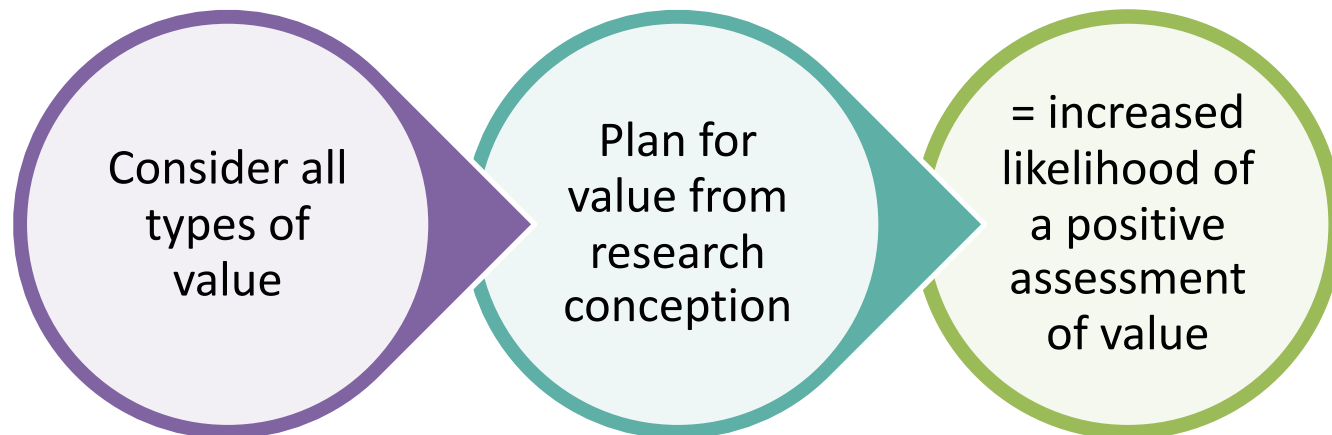

<p>Priorities are set involving those who use and are affected by health research</p> <hr/> <p>New research should be set in the context of a systematic review or rigorously determined evidence gap</p>	<p>Designed using advances in research methods and taking steps to reduce bias</p> <hr/> <p>Studies registered at inception</p>	<p>Actively manage research in a risk proportionate way</p> <hr/> <p>Protocols, methods and materials should be made available early</p>	<p>Methods, interventions and findings reported in full</p> <hr/> <p>Support replication and reuse of data</p>	<p>Findings should be set in the context of previous evidence and systematic reviews</p> <hr/> <p>Disseminate knowledge to end users. Usage of new knowledge should be supported and facilitated</p>

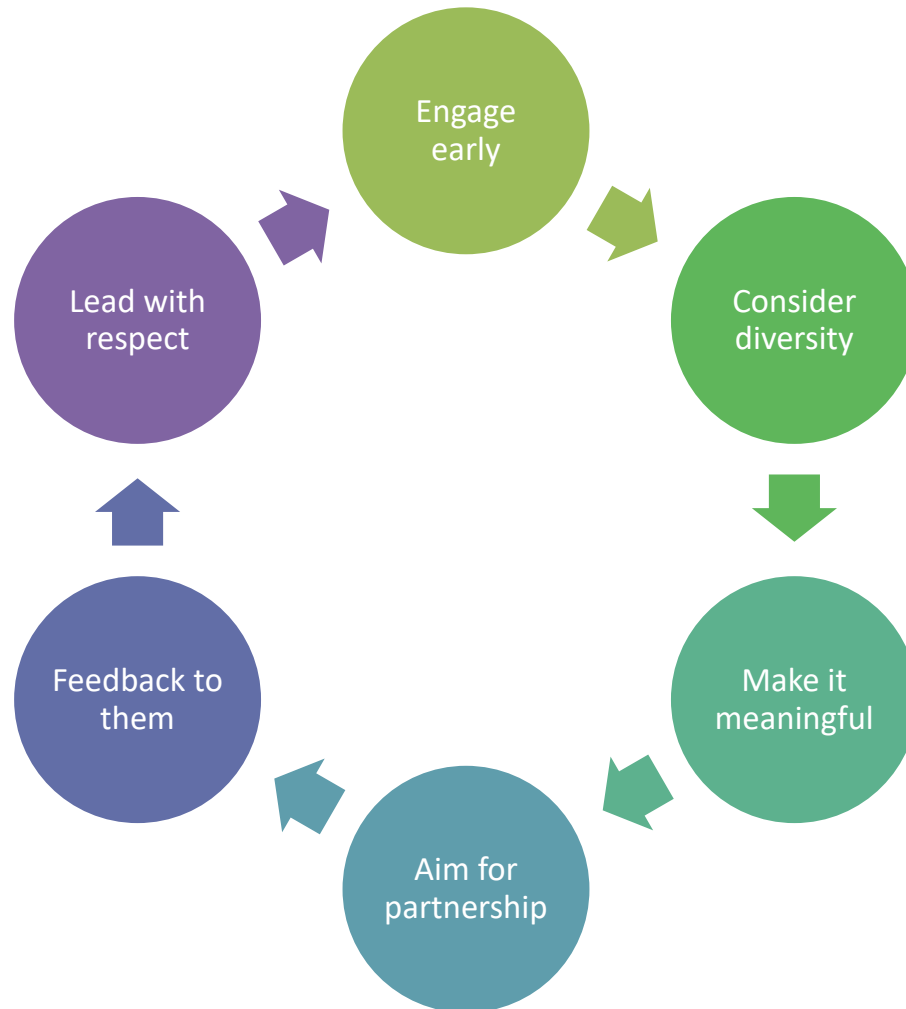

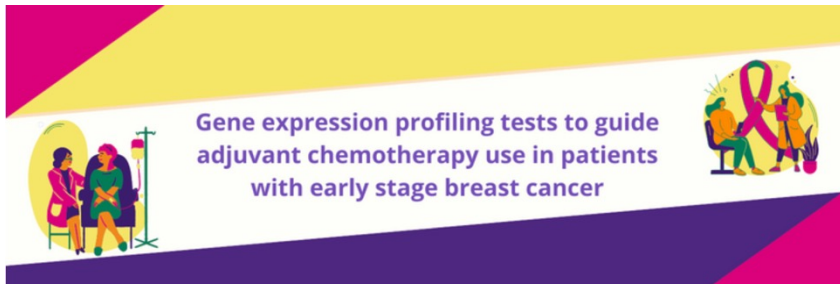

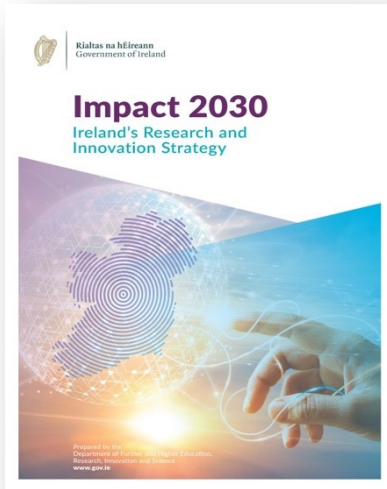


How HRCI member charities support research



Based on the responses of 25 member charities to a HRCI survey in 2023





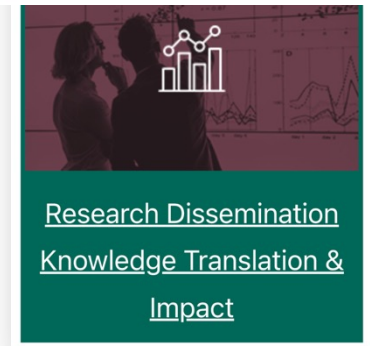
