	Inhibitors of monoamine uptake: Selective Serotonin (5-HT) Reuptake Inhibitors: Fluoxetine/Sertraline. Tricyclic antidepressants (TCA): Amitriptyline. Mixed 5-HT and noradrenaline reuptake inhibitors: Venlafaxine. Noradrenaline reuptake inhibitors: Reboxetine. Monoamine receptor antagonists: Mirtazapine.
