Statement on Feedback pertaining to admission

- 1. The competitive nature of admission to the RCSI means that many good applications are unsuccessful. The College does not provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants automatically, but will provide written feedback to unsuccessful applicants who submit a written request.
- 2. Requests for feedback on postgraduate applications should be made to the Programme Director of the course to which admission was sought.
- 3. Feedback will be provided to the applicant only, not to any third party, unless an applicant has given specific permission, in writing, for the third party to act on his/her behalf.
- 4. The College will not enter into discussions with applicants about the academic judgement behind decisions on applications.
- 5. The College maintains a Postgraduate Admissions, Complaints and Appeals Procedure Document.
- 6. Applicants who request feedback, complain, or appeal against an admissions decision, will not be disadvantaged in any way in any future applications to RCSI.
