What are the scholarships for?

How to apply?

Applicants must **apply to Uversity by 30th April 2022** with their biographical and contact details, education and employment to date, a motivation statement and details of two referees.

Successful candidates must be able to demonstrate academic potential, a clear motivation and ambition for returning to education, a drive to succeed and strong work ethic and financial need. Uversity is particularly keen to support candidates who have an ability to be transformed and transform others as a result of this scholarship and educational experience.

All applications will be reviewed by Uversity for eligibility and <u>may be</u> shortlisted for interview. Successful candidates will be notified by 1st July 2022. Scholarship offers will be made to successful candidates subject to financial assessment, confirmation of admission to a Bachelor's Programme in a participating institution and acceptance of Uversity's terms and conditions. Scholarships payments will be made monthly throughout the duration of the Bachelor's degree subject to continued academic registration and progress.
