



Outline of urological cancers where time sensitive management may be necessary during Covid-19 crisis

- 1) Patients with high grade urothelial cancer of upper tracts (kidney and ureter), bladder, urethra
 - a. Urgent TURBT
 - b. Nephroureterectomy
 - c. Cystectomy and urinary diversion*

(*may need high dependency/ICU management)

2) Testis cancer

- a. Radical orchidectomy
- b. Post chemotherapy retroperitoneal lymph node dissection for residual cancer*

(*may need high dependency/ICU management)

3) Renal cancer

a. Radical Nephrectomy for Stage T2 and above disease

4) Prostate cancer**

- a. Radical prostatectomy for high risk or unfavourable intermediate risk prostate cancer
- b. Active surveillance (Non-surgical management) for low and favourable intermediate risk prostate cancer
- ** See NCCP guidelines

5) Penile cancer

- a. Invasive penile cancer (not intraepithelial neoplasia)
- b. Regional lymph node dissection for lymph node metastases
