Revised framework for maintenance of Professional Competence Activity

1 May 2022 - 30 April 2023

The Medical Council has confirmed that the following requirements will apply for the 2022/2023 PCS Year:

- Doctors will be required to record 25 CPD credits across any of the CPD categories (external, internal, personal learning, research/teaching)

and

- Doctors will be required to complete one clinical/practice audit

RCSI continues to encourage you to take a broad approach, where possible, to ensure you participate in at least 20 hours of external activities – these can be online courses, seminars, conferences, webinars etc. Participate in and record your attendance at 20 hours of hospital-based events like Grand Rounds, MDTs and quality improvement activities (including by web conference). You should continue to read, particularly the key journals for your specialty, and record your reading under the personal learning category.

We ask that you reflect on your own practice (including the lessons from audit), consult with your peers or consultant colleague, and plan your Professional Development needs early in the PCS year.
